Children's Allergy Awareness Program launched during national PTA convention

The ACAAI Children's Allergy Awareness Program was launched at the National PTA Convention, June 18-20, in Kansas City, Mo.

More than 1,000 PTA representatives have requested information on the program, with approximately 80 percent expressing interest in having an allergist/immunologist speak at their local PTA meeting this fall.

Hundreds of PTA representatives visited the ACAAI booth during the convention, talked to College representatives about the program and picked up registration materials. District, state and national PTA leaders attended the ACAAI reception for the program.

"With allergic disorders ranking first among children's chronic diseases – and children's allergies accounting for more than 2 million missed days of school annually – the PTA leaders are very interested in our program. We can assist them in meeting their health education

goals," said Dr. Susan Rudd Wynn, ACAAI Allergy and Asthma Awareness Task Force chair and member of the Board of Regents.

"We've expanded the promotional campaign to include the National Association of School Nurses. We invited them to work with parents, teachers and allergists to help identify children who

answer questions. Presenters will be provided a College-approved speaker's kit, including slides and video clips. Local Schering representatives will deliver the speaker kits and provide on-site assistance during the PTA presentations.

A 27-minute video, *The Reason for Sneezin'*, produced for the Children's Allergy Awareness Program, will be broad-

cast on the USA Network at 8:30 a.m.(EDT) Saturday, Sept. 13, with media buys in 10 major markets.

Spanish translation is provided in the video and companion

booklet containing allergy information. The video will be available to the public through video stores and libraries.
